## Decal Placement Instructions



### Back Window

Your CAT decal should be placed on the LEFT (driver's) SIDE of your vehicle. The most visible position is the upper left corner of your rear window.

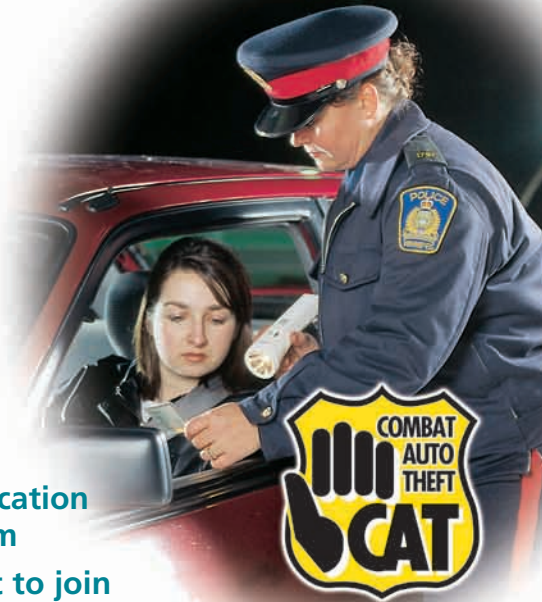

# Combat Auto Theft



*All vehicle owners suffer as a result of auto theft. The cost of claims directly affects auto insurance premiums.*

*And the cost of auto theft can far exceed dollars and cents. Lives are also placed at risk since a stolen vehicle is more likely to be involved in an accident.*

## CAT protects Manitobans.

Combat Auto Theft is a free vehicle identification program. Since its 1990 inception the province-wide program has proven to be an effective deterrent against auto theft.

Many vehicles are stolen between 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. when the owners are asleep. Often these thefts go undiscovered and unreported until long after the vehicle is gone. That gives the thief more time to escape.

Placing the CAT decal on your vehicle gives the police a better chance of arresting the thief. The decal tells police that your vehicle is not normally on the road between 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. If police spot your car on the road between those hours, they have the authority to stop it to ensure it hasn't been stolen.

## Join the CAT program. It's free.

Joining is simple. Complete the registration form and mail/deliver it to Manitoba Public Insurance, or see your local Manitoba Public Insurance Claim Centre, Autopac agent or police service. Once you join, you will receive your CAT decal to place on the inside of your vehicle's rear window.

# The CAT Declaration

I am the registered owner of the vehicle(s) described on the back of this form. I am volunteering to participate in the Combat Auto Theft (CAT) program. I will receive a CAT decal which I will place inside the upper left corner of the rear window of my vehicle(s).

By participating in the program, I am certifying that my vehicle(s) is/are not normally operated between 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. I understand the presence of the CAT decal on my vehicle(s) indicates this fact. If the police observe a person operating my vehicle during these hours, they can reasonably suspect that such a person has taken my vehicle without proper authorization. This knowledge permits the police to make an investigative stop of the vehicle.

To withdraw from this program, I understand I must fully remove the decal from my vehicle(s).

I agree to remove the decal before selling or transferring ownership of my vehicle(s).

I realize that persons operating my vehicle(s) between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., with my consent, are subject to a police stop. In these instances, police action will include the necessary precautions generally taken to protect officers when approaching a potentially stolen vehicle.

I fully understand the purpose of this program and the advantages and disadvantages, if any, that might occur from these procedures which are designed to reduce vehicle theft.

I agree that I shall indemnify and save Manitoba Public Insurance harmless from all losses, claims, damages, causes of action, demands or liabilities that may arise as a result of a CAT stop by police.

I agree to follow these procedures. I confirm that I have read this brochure and I understand it.
