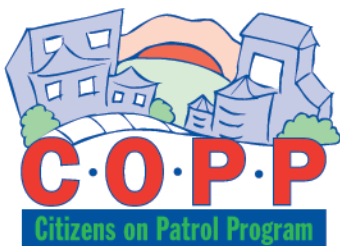


Citizens on Patrol Program

Do you Know...

The Citizens on Patrol program is a crime prevention program where community members act as extra “eyes and ears” of the community and for local law enforcement.

The goal is to improve safety in the community through deterrence, education and awareness.

◆ **Deterrence**

Identify suspicious activity and behaviour and notify local law enforcement agency. Provide a presence in the community by patrolling in vehicles, on foot and/or on bike.

◆ **Education & Awareness**

Provide general awareness and safety tips on crime prevention

Ask yourself these questions...

Am I interested in making a difference in my community?

Have I been looking for a way to get know my community better?

Do I have a couple extra hours a month to help do my part in community safety?

In Manitoba, community-based Citizens on Patrol groups have the opportunity to join the Provincial COPP Program where they can access:

- ◆ **Training**
- ◆ **Basic equipment**
- ◆ **Network opportunities**

The provincial network is co-ordinated through Manitoba Public Insurance and supported by Manitoba Justice, the R.C.M.P. and the Winnipeg Police Service through the Provincial Advisory Committee.
