Driving School instruction

A minimum 240 hours of driver training from an approved Class 1 driving school. Your tuition is paid for by the program. Students will learn about driving skills, planning trips, handling cargo, customer service, administrative duties, vehicle maintenance and how to comply with various laws, regulations, policies and standards.

On-the-job training and mentoring

Three months of paid, supervised on-the-job training from a qualified coach at a participating trucking company, and a further six months of mentoring from an experienced employee at a participating trucking firm.
