

# PIPP Benefits

Here's a list of the basic benefit amounts under PIPP. We adjust these benefits each year, based on either the Consumer Price Index or the Manitoba Average Industrial Wage.

\* Additional coverage up to a maximum of \$4,310 is also provided for accommodation, meal and travel incurred by an eligible survivor who must travel more than 50 km (100 km round-trip) from their home community to attend grief counselling. Please note: Travel expenses include bus, train or automobile travel expenses.

$\leq 20\%$ permanent impairment rating $< 50\%$	\$555 (maximum/2 years)
