Here's a list of the basic benefit amounts under PIPP. We adjust these benefits each year, based on either the Consumer Price Index or the Manitoba Average Industrial Wage.

<b>Grief counselling*</b>	\$3,762
<b>Maximum insurable gross yearly employment income</b>	\$103,500
<b>Industrial Average Wage</b>	\$979.40/week \$50,928.80/year
<b>Lump sum indemnity for each school year not completed</b>	
Minors, Kindergarten to Grade 8	\$5,609 (maximum)
Grade 9 to Grade 12	\$10,395 (maximum)
Post-secondary studies	\$20,793 (maximum)

\* Additional coverage up to a maximum of \$3,762 is also provided for accommodation, meal and travel incurred by an eligible survivor who must travel more than 50 km (100 km round-trip) from their home community to attend grief counselling. Please note: Travel expenses include bus, train or automobile travel expenses.

<b>Enhanced coverage for people catastrophically injured</b>	
Lump sum indemnity for permanent impairment	\$260,541 (maximum, includes maximum lump sum indemnity for non-catastrophic injury of \$165,002)
Personal care assistance	\$5,918 (maximum/month, includes maximum personal care assistance for non-catastrophic injury of \$4,949/month)
Transitional expense coverage	\$1,211,823 (lifetime maximum)
<b>Critical care attendance</b>	
	\$4,900 (maximum)
<b>Leisure and recreational activities</b>	
Catastrophically injured	\$4,000 (maximum/2 years)
Permanent impairment rating $\geq 70\%$	\$2,000 (maximum/2 years)
$\leq 50\%$ permanent impairment rating $< 70\%$	\$1,000 (maximum/2 years)
$\leq 20\%$ permanent impairment rating $< 50\%$	\$500 (maximum/2 years)
