1. Served or is currently serving in the Canadian Armed Forces, including those who have successfully completed basic training and have been honourably discharged.
2. Including service in the Commonwealth or its wartime allies,
3. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (as a Regular Member)
4. As a Peace Officer in a Special Duty Area or Operation.
5. Served in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime.
